Subject: Amendment in the Operational Guidelines of National Livestock Mission (NLM)

This is in reference to the National Livestock Mission operational guidelines which was published in July, 2021. This Department has been receiving requests and representations regarding amendments / modifications / clarifications from various State Governments / Union Territories / Hon'ble Member of Parliament / Bankers etc. The matter has been deliberated in the Empowered Committee held on 22.11.2022 under the chairmanship of Secretary, DAHD. The Empowered Committee has approved the following amendments in existing operational guidelines of the National Livestock Mission.

- i. In para 3.2.1: 'joint applications may also be considered as individual category of applicants
- ii. In para 5.3: after the last bullet the following amendments may be inserted:
 - The minimum beneficiary contribution for bank financed projects 10% of total project cost.
- iii. In para 5.8 after the para 5.8.3, a new para 5.8.4 as under shall be inserted:

5.8.4: Administrative Cost: The Department will also provide Rs. 1.05 Crore (100% central share) as yearly funding to the State Implementing Agency towards administrative cost for inviting proposals from the beneficiaries, awareness creation and handholding of beneficiaries to facilitate them to get bank loan etc. A detailed component wise breakup of the administrative cost is as follows:

Note-

- Salary adjustments up to 10% in annual increments may be permitted for Veterinary Graduates and Data Entry Operators engaged.
- Computer/Mobile/Printer etc equipment should not be purchased every year. It should be based on the actual requirement for implementation of NLM EDP.
- In case of States having huge numbers of eligible applications, if required State can propose for more administrative cost in proportionate to this cost structure. That will be evaluated by PAC on case-to-case basis.

- In para 5.8.1.2: the following shall be substituted in place of existing first para:**

In respect of the entrepreneurship programme, the subsidy will be provided by SIDBI to the lending scheduled bank or Financial Institutions like NCDC etc. to the subsidy account of beneficiaries. The SIDBI on receipt of the subsidy component, shall release the first instalment of subsidy to the appropriate account of Entrepreneurs/ Eligible Entities after disbursement of minimum 25% of total loan sanctioned. The SIDBI needs to open dedicated account for subsidy and shall intimate the DAHD for mapping in PFMS System. The manner of subsidy release has been mentioned against each entrepreneurship component.

- In para 6.1.1: Activity II: The unit size for Establishment of Entrepreneurship for breed development in small ruminant sector (sheep & goat farming) and Activity IV: Promotion of Piggery Entrepreneur, may be considered as under:**

Under Activity II: Establishment of Entrepreneur for breed development in small ruminant sector (sheep & goat farming), the Entrepreneurs / Eligible Entities can establish sheep and goat breeding unit with minimum 100 females and 05 males and can apply in multiple of 100+5 unit with a maximum limit up to 500+25 unit. Accordingly, 50% capital subsidy up to following subsidy ceiling will be provided to beneficiaries:



Under Activity IV: Promotion of Piggery Entrepreneur, the entrepreneur will be provided assistance for the establishment of a breeder farm with minimum 50 sows and 05 boars. The applicant can also establish breeder farm with 100 sow and 10 boars. Accordingly, 50% capital subsidy up to following subsidy ceiling will be provided to beneficiaries:

Unit Size for Piggery Farm	Max amount of capital subsidy
50 sows +5 boars	15 lakhs
100 sows+10 boars	30 lakhs

vi. The following clarifications are also approved by Empowered Committee:

- The applicant may also be eligible for applying for more than one component in NLM EDP simultaneously.
- More than one adult member of a family may also be eligible to apply and may avail benefits under the NLM EDP scheme, provided he/she fulfils the eligibility criteria.
- The beneficiary needs to hold a savings account in the lender bank and the bank will release subsidy in savings account of beneficiary and not in loan account.
