It has been decided by the Department to approve CALG lab, Thiruvananthapuram as referral lab to conduct testing of bulls available at Semen Stations for (i) genetic disorders, (ii) Karyotyping, (iii) parentage testing, (iv) A1A2 allele detection; (iv) IBR screening; Campylobacteriosis; (v) Vibriosis; (vi) Brucellosis or any other disease as listed in disease prevention protocol subject to the condition that bull available at semen stations in Kerala shall not be tested by CALG.
- 3. For genomic testing common chip is being developed and same common chip shall be utilized by the lab for this purpose. The decision on genomic testing shall be taken after discussion with NDDB and other stake holders.
